Cllr Susan Robson declared an interest in item 4 on the agenda 'To consider additional submission to Planning Inspectorate following notice of appeal for Christleton Hall Planning Application 17/04127/FUL' and would not take part in any discussions on this agenda item.

TRAFFIC & ROAD SAFETY

To finalise and approve Terms of Reference for Traffic Working Group

1. The draft Terms of Reference were circulated to all Councillors for their consideration and discussion.
2. The TOR covered the purpose of the working group, membership criteria, accountability, review process, working methods, impact statements on wellbeing, inclusion and diversity, financial impact, legal impact, environmental impact, social and community impact, political and economic impact.
3. A number of amendments and inclusions were discussed and agreed, the document will be amended to reflect these changes.
Resolved: A motion was put forward for councillors to vote to accept and approve the Terms of Reference was passed unanimously.
Action: Following the decision the TOR to be forwarded to the list of volunteers who have put their names forward to sit on the TWG. They will be required to sign the document to confirm that they will abide by the Terms of Reference should they be invited to join the group.
4. The group which is being set up to assist Christleton Parish Council to improve the safety of the highways in the village, will comprise of 8 members (two from CPC and 6 others) with the final decision who serves on the group being made by Christleton Parish Council.

Planning

To consider additional submission to the Planning Inspectorate following the notice of appeal for Christleton Hall Planning Application 17/04124/FUL

Resolved: Following receipt of the notice of appeal it was agreed by a vote of 4 for with Cllr Tonge and one other abstention, that Cllr Henley would compile an additional submission to the Council's previous objections to this planning application and that he represents the Parish Council at the Planning Appeal hearing when the date of the appeal hearing is confirmed.
